



VISITOR POLICY

The Western Mass. Food Processing Center is an FDA regulated Facility. All visitors must sign in and out and must wear designated clothing, headwear and footwear when entering the food handling and processing areas.

- Hair Nets and beard nets (if applicable) are required;
- No jewelry can be worn, or must be covered;
- No one under the age of 18, including infants, are permitted in the center;
- No loose or flowing clothing, or tank tops, shoulders must be covered;
- No open toed shoes, high heels or sandals allowed in processing area;
- No eating, drinking, smoking, chewing gum or tobacco, or using medication is allowed.
- No wearing of perfume or cologne;
- Anyone that has or shows symptoms of a disease or illness that can be transmitted through food, or anyone that may have been exposed to someone who is ill is not allowed inside;
- Anyone with a cut or open wound must cover the area with a waterproof protective bandage;
- All visitors must be accompanied by an employee. This employee will ensure that visitors follow the company's personnel practices program;
- Visitors must keep all production information confidential;
- No photos of active productions, ingredients, processes or employees are allowed without permission.
